

One Week Itinerary

Day 1

Grinda

59° 24.890' N

18° 33.282' E

Nice guest harbor located on the northwest side of the island Grinda. It has two restaurants, showers and shops. The harbor staff can be contacted at any time on the harbor telephone: +46 702-45 57 74.

Facilities:

Shore power, showers, toilets, water, food shop and garbage disposal. Wireless internet is available at a cost, tickets can be purchased at the harbor office.

Cost (2011):

250 SEK + 50 SEK per night for shore power. Toilets and showers are included.

Day 2

Finnhamn

59° 28.9' N

18° 49.6' E

12 nautical miles from Grinda

Finnhamn is a small quite group of islands with many small natural harbors to choose from. The islands are full of trees and there are plenty of paths through the rich flora. There is a little restaurant and small food store. The approach to the harbor is quite narrow and has several rocks to be aware of. When approaching from the south, be sure to pass to the east of the red buoy at 59° 28.883' N, 18° 49.695' E.

Facilities:

Shore power, Toilets, garbage disposal, showers.

Free - you are free to spend the night in a natural harbor.

Day 3

Sandhamn

15.5 nautical miles from Finnhamn

Sandhamn is a very popular destination during the summer. Here you will find something for everyone – nice restaurants, bars, minigolf, a spa and more. The best approach to Sandhamn is through the marked channel between Sandön and Telegrafholmen.

Facilities:

Shore power, showers, toilets, water, garbage disposal, gas station, wireless internet, post box, laundry, bakery and food shops.

Cost (2011):

Under 40 foot: 300 SEK + 80 SEK per night for shore power.

Over 40 foot: 450 SEK + 80 SEK per night for shore power.

Malma Kvarn

12 nautical miles from Sandhamn

Utö

25 nautical miles from Malma Kvarn

Ute is a larger harbor with many restaurants, shops and bars. It is a very popular destination for both Swedish and international visitors during the summer. It is possible to rent bicycles here and explore the island on your own.

Facilities:

Shore power, showers, toilets, water, garbage disposal, gas station, post box, laundry, sauna, and food shops.

190 SEK + 55 SEK per night for shore power. Toilets, shower and sauna are included.

Dalarö

15 nautical miles from Utö

Dalarö is a harbor with several restaurants, café, golf course and sauna.

Facilities:

Shore power, showers, toilets, water, garbage disposal, gas station, laundry, sauna, and food shops.

200 SEK + 40 SEK per night for shore power. Toilets, shower and sauna are included.

Wasahamnen, Stockholm City

24 nautical miles from Dalarö

Wasahamnen is in the heart of Stockholm. Here you will find everything – a wide variety of restaurants, bars, clubs, parks, museums, cafés and more. The green natural area Djurgården and lively Östermalm are both within walking distance.

Facilities:

Shore power, showers, toilets, water, garbage disposal, gas station, post box, laundry, sauna, and food shops, restaurants.

Under 40 feet: 250 SEK + 40 SEK per night for shore power.

Over 40 feet: 500 SEK + 40 SEK per night for shore power.
